

MATER DOLOROSA EXTENDED CARE PROGRAM

COVID PROTOCOLS

- All students will need to wash or sanitize their hands before entering The Extended Care Program space. Backpacks and belongings will be kept in the hallway, allowing more space for the students to social distance by grade level cohorts in the cafeteria.
- Students will bring only their snack and any homework/books with them into the cafeteria.
- Masks will be required of ALL students when entering and exiting The Extended Day Program. Students in grades 2-8, and all adults working in the program, will wear masks at all times. If able to social distance by 6 feet, students may take mask breaks. Mask wearing will be encouraged, but not required, for students in preschool thru 1st grade.
- Students will be social distanced around the cafeteria or space they are occupying by grade level cohorts.
- Windows will be open, when allowable, for ventilation.
- Weather permitting, students will be going outside for fresh air
- Upon exiting, students will sanitize hands.
- Students will be dismissed to the parent/person picking them up at the after-school door and will be signed out there. This will limit the number of visitors entering the school.
- The Extended Care space will be cleaned before and after students leave the program. Toys, games, materials used by students will be rotated in and out and cleaned after use. Parents are encouraged to send a plastic closing bag or small container with items (i.e. pencils, crayons, eraser, markers, and scissors) that only your child will use while at The Extended Care Program. Please label your child's materials.
